**\*\*\*** U.S.A., by John Dos Passos. \$3.00. *Harcourt, Brace.* Reprint of a monumental American novel composed of three sections originally published as *The 42nd Parallel, Nineteen Nineteen,* and *The Big Money.* Assuredly a great book.

\*\*\*\* THE DEVIL AND DANIEL WEB-STER, Stephen Vincent Benét. \$1.00. Farrar & Rinehart. A fine and famous short story now issued in book form.

★★★ MYSTERY WEEK-END, by Percival Wilde. \$2.00. *Harcourt, Brace*. Forty guests arrive at a New England inn for a week-end of Winter sports, and shortly thereafter the inevitable corpse is discovered. Veteran murder-story readers will guess the solution, but the tale is well-constructed and engagingly written.

★★★ TO THE LIGHTHOUSE, by Virginia Woolf. \$.95. *Modern Library*. For those who like Virginia Woolf.

★★★ OLD LONDON, by E. F. Benson. \$5.00. Appleton Century. Four volumes of Mr. Benson's good work, each covering a definite period of London history: Portrait of an English Nobleman (Georgian); Janet (Victorian); Friend of the Rich (Mid-Victorian); and The Unwanted (Edwardian).

\*\*\* O. HENRY MEMORIAL AWARD PRIZE STORIES OF 1937. Edited by Harry Hansen. \$2.50. *Doubleday Doran*. Each year a uniformly good collection of firstrate short stories.


**\*\*\*** BERNARD DE VOTO, by Garrett Mattingly. \$1.00. *Little, Brown*. An extremely well-written appraisal of the talented editor-critic who seems to be baffling both the Comrades of the Left and the mossbacks of the Right.

 $\star\star\star$  CONQUEROR OF THE SEAS, by Stefan Zweig. Translated by Eden and Cedar Paul, \$3.50. Viking. The fifteenth century sired robust navigators, among them Ferdinand Magellan, the Portuguese who sailed Spain's flag across the earth in 1519. Five ships and 265 men commenced the westward voyage, encountering the concomitants of travel in those days: shipwreck, hunger, and mutiny. Magellan lost his life upon the spears of island natives. The Victoria alone returned to Spain, bearing eighteen survivors and commanded by a mutincer, Del Cano. He earned Magellan's rightful reward, thus repeating history's favorite prank. Herr Zwieg presents a scholarly and sympathetic biography, containing new material from the survivors' diaries.

★★ BRISBANE: A CANDID BIOGRA-PHY, by Oliver Carlson. \$3.00. Stackpole. Mr. Carlson presents without reticence Mr. Hearst's great editor. Certainly Brisbane met a demand with a supply: he amused and misinstructed millions of mouth-breathers through more than a generation, serving them food adjusted to their capacities: and they gave him ample reward. But the impression the biography leaves is one word: Jackal.
