

SATAN DECEIVES WOMEN

THE "Mystery of Sex" is stated with authority to be the Supreme Mystery from which all other mysteries come. It is sealed and it is the most hidden and concealed of all the Mysteries.

The Mystery of Sex is the Mystery of Creation. Remember it is beneath the Mother's heart that every human being is created. Mothers, therefore, are partners with God, or special instruments of God. Mother love is unsurpassed on earth, God is love. Remember, God creates and Satan destroys. But Moses taught men to be destroyers and to be *cunning* in bringing about wars. He outlined in *Deuteronomy* 2:24-26 seven ways of betraying all nations. Moses advanced Satan's plan to destroy. Moses said, "Woman was created by man from the ribs of Adam."

A destroyer plan operates behind the plan substituted by Moses for the Creator's plan. As you will learn, the destroyer's plan is "The Hidden Government."

If the wife was one of the heads of this or any Government, she, as a Mother with authority, would not tolerate destruction. She would not consent to or be bound by Satan's plan which sends forth other women's sons and husbands

to destroy each other. There would be love where Moses planted hate. And there would be peace and not continual war. Furthermore, women *enjoy* the reputation of not being able to keep secrets. And if there were no secrets, Satan's diabolical plan could not continue to deceive the world. The men, obviously the Cabalist, express their worry in the scriptures with these words: "Keep the doors of thy mouth from her that lieth at thy bosom." (*Micah* 7:5) This is intended against wives also.

The book, *The Secret Doctrine in Israel* by A. E. Waite, Page 156, states "The Supreme Mystery" and the "Mystery of faith" (in laws and dogma) are one. They are the source of all other mysteries.

Throughout the ages Satan has conspired against women.

1. *The past.* Moses said in *Genesis* 3:15, 16 "And I put ENMITY between thee and women," etc. This is destructive. Satan's and Moses' plan is to destroy!

Moses said woman is inferior in every way. Moses commanded women to be faithful to one man, but the men could have as many wives and concubines as they could buy or capture. King David, following Moses' doctrine, added to

his number of concubines. He also locked part of them up and they died. His son, Solomon by Bathsheba, whose husband David had murdered—had 700 wives and 300 concubines. (*II Samuel* 5:13; *II Samuel* 20:3, *I Kings* 11:3)

Moses divided 32,000 helpless virgins between his men who had already destroyed their parents and brothers. (*Numbers* 31, 7-18) The Hebrew Bible, The Talmud, says that a man can take and possess a baby girl of age three years and a day. Moses' men stole peoples' flocks, cattle, silver, gold and burned their castles, etc. (*Numbers* 31) "Utterly destroying the men, women and children of every city." (*Deuteronomy* 12: 2-5)

Moses demanded that women who gave birth to female babies must be forced to stay out of the tabernacle twice as long as when their babies were males. (*Leviticus* 12: 2-5)

Moses commanded that the penalty was DEATH to any wife who was unfaithful to her husband.

Moses did not write the *Book of Genesis* but he revised it. In it he was kinder to the lowest thing that creeps on the earth than he was to women. To all men and women whom God created, Moses wrote only that God had instructed men and women to be fruitful and multiply. He left out "After his own kind" concerning man "WHOM GOD CREATED IN HIS OWN LIKENESS." Although he instructed the beast

of the field, the birds of the air, the fish in the sea, in this manner.

Because we lived under Moses' Law, women have suffered unmercifully in the past. Today, under the same laws of Moses, women are still suffering. They live in ignorance of the conspirator's plan.

MOSES SAID, "Let him that has corrupted a virgin, not yet espoused, marry her, but if the father of the damsel be not willing that she should be his wife, *let him pay 50 shekels as the price of prostitution.*"

And they slew the kings of Midian, beside the rest of them that were slain; . . . and the children of Israel took all the women of Midian captives, and their little ones, and took the spoil of all their cattle, and all their flocks, and all their goods. And they burnt all their cities wherein they dwelt, and all their goodly castles, with fire . . . And Moses was wroth with the officers of the host . . . And Moses said unto them, Have ye saved all the women alive? . . . Now therefore kill every male among the little ones, and kill every woman that hath known man by lying with him. But all the women children, that have not known a man by lying

with him, keep alive for yourselves."

JESUS, the Son of God, loved little children.

Moses was unmerciful to little children and slaughtered them by the tens of thousands.

Jesus pitied the women of Jerusalem and said, "Daughters of Jerusalem, weep not for me, but weep for yourselves and for your children. For behold the days are coming in which they shall say 'Blessed are the barren and the womb that never bore.'" *Luke 23:28, 29*

2. *The present.* It is during the prebirth period that determines the abilities of each of us. When woman is downtrodden, under pressure, toils, worries, burdens, on toxic from the poisons of drugs, bad food, cigarettes, etc., the entire life of their baby is affected. This applies to both male and female. What happens to the unborn infant affects the world for a century.

3. Women have to give up their men, husbands and sons to fight wars that are promoted by Moses' Laws. The Pharisee Plan is for a program of constant warfare and disintegration.

separated from husbands and children. (*Zechariah 12:12-14*)

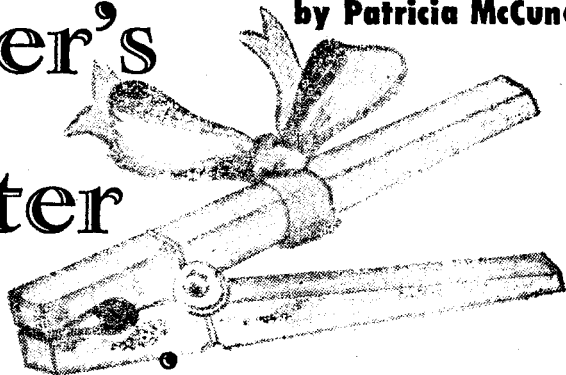
