An authoritative, moderate, and constructive document.

THE BRITISH TRADE BOARDS SYSTEM. BY D. SELLS. London: King, 1924, 304 pp.

A valuable study of post-war reconstruction problems in the labor field.

LE IMPÉRIALISME ANGLO-SAXON. BY J. AUDEMAR. Paris: Nouvelle Librairie Nationale, 1923.

An account of alleged British and American imperialism, economic and political, and of avowed French pacifism and economic and colonial weakness.

THE HISTORY OF IRELAND. BY STEPHEN GWYNN. New York: Macmillan, 1923, 549 pp.

A well-written general history of Ireland, anecdotal and episodic in character. Brief on the nineteenth century.

INDIA IN 1922-23. BY L. F. R. WILLIAMS. Calcutta: Government Printing Office, 1923.

A readable survey of India today.

MAHATMA GHANDI. BY ROMAIN ROLLAND. New York: Century, 1924, 250 pp.

A masterly, if mystical, interpretative biography.

INDIAN EXPORT TRADE. BY R. M. JOSHI. Bombay: Sydenham College of Commerce and Economics, 1923, 195 pp.

A compilation containing illuminating charts and statistics.

THE COÖPERATIVE MOVEMENT IN INDIA. BY P. MUKHERJI. Calcutta: Thacker and Spink, 1923, 468 pp.

A largely rewritten edition of the standard work on Indian coöperation.

HINDUSTANI WORKERS ON THE PACIFIC COAST. BY R. K. DAS. Berlin: Gruyter, 1923.

A study of the problem of the Indian laborers on the Pacific coast in the United States and Canada.

CHINESE COOLIE EMIGRATION TO COUNTRIES WITHIN THE BRITISH EMPIRE. BY P. C. CAMPBELL. London: King, 1924, 240 pp.

A scholarly examination of a rather startling situation.

The Near East

MANUEL HISTORIQUE DE LA QUESTION D'ORIENT. BY J. ANCEL. Paris: Delgrave, 1923.

A lucid and objective account of European diplomacy in the Near East from 1792 to 1923.

COMPÉTENCE ET DEMOCRATIE. BY P. STAINOF. Sofia: 1923.

A study of the peasant régime of Stamboulisky in Bulgaria in the light of modern democratic theory.

THE STRUGGLE FOR POWER IN MOSLEM ASIA. BY E. A. POWELL. New York: Century, 1924, 389 pp.

A severe indictment of western imperialism in the Near East.

LE DRAME ORIENTAL ET LE ROLE DE LA FRANCE. BY P. LYAUTEY. Paris: Société d'Éditions Géographiques Maritimes et Coloniales, 1923.

A history of the struggles of Germany and England for the hegemony of the Near East, with a plea for a more determined and better considered French participation.

LA SYRIE SOUS LE MANDAT FRANÇAIS. BY P. CLERGET. Paris: Revue Économique Internationale, 1923.

An excellent, if enthusiastic, brochure describing the establishment and early results of the French mandate in Syria.

LA FRANCE ET LA QUESTION DE MOSSOUL. BY R. DE GONTAUT-BIRON. Paris: Société d'Études et d'Informations Économiques, 1923.

A sketch of the struggle of France and England for the possession of this important oil district.

LA POLITIQUE ORIENTALE DE L'ALLEMAGNE EN PERSE. Paris: Leroux, 1923.

An account of German policy in Persia in the last generation.

THE LAUSANNE TREATY AND KEMALIST TURKEY. New York: American Committee for the Independence of Armenia, 1924, 79 pp.

A collection of violently anti-Turkish papers.

LAUSANNE ET LES VIEILLARDS. BY R. COLRAT. Paris: Librairie Littéraire et Scientifique, 1923.

A vigorous criticism of the diplomacy at the Lausanne Conference.

LE DRAME ORIENTAL. BY B. BAREILLES. Paris: Bossard, 1923.

The author holds that France was defeated at Lausanne and predicts the ultimate triumph of Greece in the Near East.

L'AGONIE DES CAPITULATIONS. BY A. MESTRE. Paris: Editions de la Revue de Paris, 1923.

An extremely clear legal analysis of the capitulations, criticising their inadequacy.

A PALESTINE NOTEBOOK, 1918-1923. BY C. R. ASHBEE. London: Heinemann, 1923.

A keen, critical interpretation of the Zionist experiment.

Africa

RAW PRODUCTS OF THE WORLD. VOL. I. AFRICA. BY R. DAVOL. Taunton, Massachusetts: 1923, 264 pp.

A valuable compendium for those interested in foreign trade, somewhat unscientifically compiled.

EQUATORIA: THE LADO ENCLAVE. BY C. H. STIGAND. London: Constable, 1923, 253 pp.

A thorough study of the southern Sudan and its problems.

L'AFRIQUE OCCIDENTALE FRANÇAISE. BY E. PELLERAY. Paris: Notre Domaine Colonial, 1923, 132 pp.

A good sketch of economic and administrative problems and achievements.

THE EDGE OF THE DESERT. BY J. DUNBAR. London: Allen, 1923, 148 pp.

An interesting description of the manners and customs of Tunis under French rule.
