DIRECTIONS

When you have guessed a word fill it in on the dashes; then write each letter in the correspondingly num-bered square of the puz-zle diagram. When the squares are all filled in you will find (by read-ing from left to right) a quotation from a famous author. Read up and down the letters mean nothing. The black squares indicate ends of words; words do not necessarily end at the right side of the diagram. 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
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


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
