

Feathers

■T IS RARE in this day that craftsmanship is publicly applauded, except where craftsmanship is indistinguishable from "ART" in capital letters. Criticism in the press, so far as I know, has been limited to the so-called creative arts. Praise, or blame, is heaped on the heads of directors, actors, writers, composers, musicians, poets-even chefs. Once in a great while an outstanding architect, a furniture designer, or a teacher is singled out for a compliment-or a denunciation. But where has there been printed a critique of the craftsmanship of, say, an excellent shoemaker, an outstanding cabinetmaker, or, to come closer to home, a peerless sound recordist? It is not that, because I am a sound technician myself, I equate the talents of a good cabinetmaker, for instance, with those of any sound recordist. The cabinetmaker, I am sure, knows as much of his craft as I know of mine. Even Chippendale himself, however, was not more of a craftsman in his metier than Dr. Peter Paul Kellogg of Cornell is in his - the ornithological craft, or art, of recording bird songs.

Although the critical fraternity as a whole has not yet recognized Dr. Kellogg's craftsmanship, connoisseurs within the publishing industry have done so. Recognition took the form of a Carey-Thomas Award (honorable mention) to the Houghton Mifflin Company for Roger Tory Peterson's "A Field Guide to Bird Songs," created by Professors Kellogg and Allen of Cornell's Laboratory of Ornithology. The Carey-Thomas Awards perpetuate the memory of two pioneer American publishers, Isaiah Thomas and Mathew Carev, who, in the opinions of some, are patron saints of the American publishing industry. The judging is done by a jury of five nominated by the office of Publisher's Weekly, and the
