# RUM COLLINS

-how to make it

Nobody knows where the word "collins" came from. But the drink itself was first concocted with rum, by an innkeeper during the American Revolution. Still unbeatable.

1 oz. lemon juice, 1 tsp. sugar (or, use a prepared collins mix). Add 2 oz. white or silver Puerto Rican rum, shake with ice, strain into a tall glass full of ice cubes, and top with water or club soda.
